

GA4GH STANDARDS FOR PROFESSIONAL CONDUCT

Approved by the Steering Committee, 22 January 2018

<u>Introduction:</u> The purpose of these Standards are to ensure that all contributors to GA4GH promote the mission of the GA4GH and maintain a professional and respectful environment. It applies to all activities and interactions of those contributors involving GA4GH.

GA4GH Contributors Shall:

- Adhere to GA4GH's mission and <u>Framework for Responsible Sharing of Genomic and Health</u>
 Related Data.
- Act to uphold the interests and reputation of the GA4GH.
- Promote standards, policies, and products that contribute to scientific and technological advancement that improves human health, e.g., by offering competent opinions and services, and considering diverse viewpoints.
- Treat all colleagues with respect, courtesy, and professionalism.
- Commit to the highest standards of objectivity and transparency concerning credentials,
 qualifications, and conflicts of interests.
- Respect GA4GH policies as established on the GA4GH website or within Work Streams.

<u>Uptake:</u> These standards will be shared on the GA4GH website, and will provided to new contributors when they join Work Streams.
